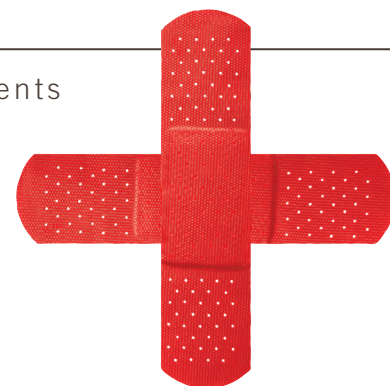

Danny Dwyer

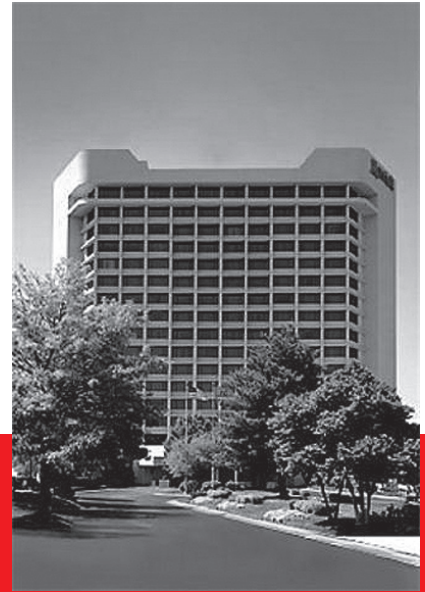

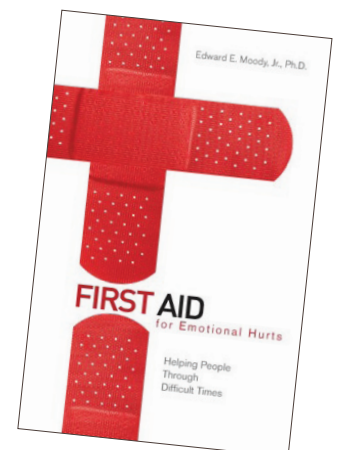

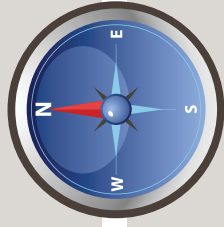
First Aid for Emotional Hurts by Edward J. Moody, Jr.
