

## MINUTES

of the

### FIRST DISTRICT QUARTERLY MEETING OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF THE N. C. ASSOCIATION OF ORIGINAL FREE WILL BAPTISTS

The First District Quarterly Meeting of the General Conference of the N. C. Association of Original Free Will Baptists met at the White Oak Hill Free Will Baptist Church, Bailey, N. C., on January 26, 1968.

Rev. Eddie Dollar opened the meeting by leading the congregation in a hymn, after which the Rev. Gordon Sebastian led in prayer.

Special music was rendered by a Quarter from the Peace Free Will Baptist Church in Wilson, N. C. A panel, consisting of the Revs. Chester Phillips, Robert Durham, J. W. Long, Jr., and Glenn Hill, spoke on topics pertaining to youth. The congregation was then given an opportunity to direct questions concerning the topics discussed, to a panel of teenagers, who represented the various churches in the district.

An offering of \$20.40 was received during the meeting for National Home Missions.

Following the program, we entered into a brief Business Session with the Moderator, Rev. Henry Hughes, presiding. The following items of business were enacted:

1. Motion was made and seconded that Rev. Edwin L. Hill be re-elected as Clerk-Treasurer of the Quarterly Meeting for a period of one year. Motion carried.
2. Motion was made and carried to receive the Revs. Robert Durham, J. C. Cooley, and Joe Dan Underwood into our fellowship, with the Moderator extending the right hand of fellowship.
3. Motion was made and carried to receive the Grace Free Will Baptist Church, Rocky Mount, into our fellowship.
4. Motion was made and carried that: (a) The Quarterly Meeting adopt the project of furnishing one room in the new boys dorm at the Free Will Baptist Bible College, with a goal of \$400.00 being set for this. Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) was designated for the project at this meeting, leaving a balance of \$325.00 to be raised. (b) The Quarterly Meeting send Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) to the N. C. Association for the Station Wagon project.
5. Motion made and carried to accept the invitation of the Grace Free Will Baptist Church, Rocky Mount, to have the next meeting there--April 19, 1968.

The minutes of the last meeting and the Treasurer's Report were approved as printed.

There were ten Pastor's present, and nine churches represented, with fourteen delegates registering.

Motion made and carried to adjourn. Rev. Ronald Creech dismissed the meeting in prayer.
