## FRIDAY MORNING SESSION

The Friday morning session began with Bro. Ron Christ leading the congregation in singing, "Glory To His Name" and "Joy Unspeakable." Devotional remarks were made by Rev. Bill Robinson, pastor of Prospect Free Will Baptist Church of Dunn. He used Matt. 14:22-27 for his text and his thoughts in summary were, "though the church has turmoils to go through in this life, Christ has promised us the Victory in the end. Therefore, we should keep on, keeping on in carrying out His commandments."

Rev. Gordon Sebastian, pastor of Peace Free Will Baptist Church of Wilson presided over the morning session, introducing the program. Everyone welcomed one another to the session while singing the song, "Heavenly Sunshine."

Rev. Dean Dobbs, pastor of shady Grove Free Will Baptist Church of Durham and moderator of this session, called the meeting to order.

Rev. Ronald Howland, host pastor, welcomed the conference to the Mount Calvary Free Will Baptist Church.

The moderator addressed the session pointing out that we as a conference need to be strong in our resources and our responsibilities.

Motion was made and carried to seat the delegates representing member churches of the General Conference.

Motion was made and carried to approve the program for the day, giving the moderator authority to make necessary changes.

The clerk, Ronnie Peele, gave a brief report in behalf of the National Foreign Mission Dept. Missionaries Bobby Aycock and Bill Fulcher, natives of North Carolina, are in much need for more support given toward their "total ministry cost".

Minutes of the One Hundred-Forty-sixth Annual Session of the General Conference were read and approved with the addition that the names of the ministers and delegates present at that annual session be recorded in the minutes.

Rev. Gordon Sebastian gave a report for the National Home Mission Board. Some of the things that our National Home Mission Board is doing is: In one of the Board's regular business meetings, a motion was made and passed that no member of the Home Mission Board represent in the N.A.E. (National Association of Evangelicals); a greater emphasis is being placed on Personal Soul Winning for pastors; a plea for experienced pastors that have been successful in pastoring churches to apply and work new mission points under the National Home Mission Board.

Rev. Herman Hersey gave a report for the National Sunday School Department. He said the new curriculum of teaching material is being well received over our Denomination. One of the new ministries now being offered is Cassette Recorders with teaching Bible studies.

Rev. Ronald Creech, our State Evangelist, gave a report of the various works across our State. He said that there are a small number of churches that support the total ministry of our State Program. He challenged everyone to support our State Program regularly. In his reporting he said the Home of the Aged is operating in the black; the Witness Book Store gross sales last year was \$37,400.00; Capital Church Bonds now has three-part-time men helping on the field, Ed Hill, Tom Lilly, and Billy Adam; the Witness paper now has a circulation of 5,700 copies each month.

Rev. Jack Paramore gave a report for Free Will Baptist Bible College. He said The Bible College was \$100,000.00 in debt though its assets have increased to around \$2,000,000.00. The College is beyond the half-way mark in its building program. Presently, a new building that will house the Girls Dormitory and Dining Hall is being built for the cost of \$890,000.00. Plans for a Physical Education Building are now being drawn up.

The moderator recognized our visiting ministers. They were: James Stepps, Coastal Association; Dough Robinson, Tide-water Association-Virginia; Billy Morris, Norfolk, Va.; Gene Parish, Hampton, Va.; and Raymond Riggs, Detroit, Michigan.

Rev. Herman Hersey gave a report for the Superannuation Board. One new field the Retirement Board has entered into is a Special Trust Fund for churches.

Rev. James Denton gave a report for the State Mission Board. He urged the pastors to support the Church Extension Volunter project. He reported all the mission points were doing good.

Motion was made and carried to accept the above mentioned reports.

Bro. Ron Christ led the singing for the Morning Worship Service. After singing, "Since Jesus Came Into Heart", Rev. Joe Hailey led the Service in prayer. An offering was received with Rev. Gene Hales offering the offertory prayer. The congregation then sang, "At Calvary". Mrs. Mattie McLawhorn, from Mount Calvary Church sang a solo entitled, "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus." The morning message was delivered by Rev. Dale Burden, pastor of Fairmont Park F.W.B. Church in Norfolk, Va. His text was taken from II Samuel 15:17-21. His topic was, "Allegiance to Jesus". Rev. Rashie Kennedy prayed the benediction at the end of the service.

### FRIDAY AFTERNOON SESSION

Rev. Lorenza Stox led the afternoon service in singing, "My Saviours Love." Rev. Ron Niebruegge, pastor of Unity Free Will Baptist Church in Smithfield, presided over the afternoon session and introduced Rev. Gordon Hart, pastor of Griffon Free Will Baptist Church, for our devotions. Bro. Hart's text was I John 1:1-4, speaking on, "Fellowship With God".

Moderator Dean Dobbs called the business meeting back in session.

Rev. Raymond Riggs, visiting from Michigan, and Mrs. Mabel Willey, Missionary Deputational Representative, both gave words of testimony. Rev. Gene Hales gave a report for the National Church Training Service Board. He said the sales of literature was up with over 800 churches using the literature. He said it is the first time in history that the current bills are paid. He appealed for you to attend the National Association, July, 1971, in Nashville, Tenn.

Motion was made and carried to accept the Treasurers Report.

Motion was made and carried for five men to be elected by the body, to revise the constitution. The five men elected were; Herman Hersey, L. R. Ennis, A. C. Morgan, Ronald Niebruegge and Frank Davenport.

Motion was made and carried to adopt the Membership Committee's Report and consider it item by item. \* See Report in Back.

Motion was made and carried to amend motion and delete the words, "Minister of Education" on Harley Bennett.

Motions were made and carried on other items on the Membership Committee's Report.

Motion was made and carried to receive the Youth Committee's Report. A motion for some means of financial support be promoted for expenses was amended to whatever is deemed justifiable by the board, was carried. \* See Report in Back.

Motion was made and carried to accept the Nominating Committee Report, and voted on each office item by item. \* See Report in Back.

Motion was made and carried for the Moderator to appoint the delegates to represent the General Conference at the State Association.

Motion was made to adjourn by Rev. L. D. Creech. Motion was passed.

Prayer of dismissal was offered by Rev. Herman Hersey.

#### FRIDAY EVENING SESSION

With Rev. James Denton, pastor of HillTop Free Will Baptist Church of Fuquay-Varina, presiding over the evening session, Rev. Lorenza Stox led the congregation singing "Tis The Old Time Religion." Rev. L. D. Creech led in prayer. Other congregational songs were "When the Trumpet of the Lord" and "Victory In Jesus". An offering was received and special music was rendered by the host church. Larry Cox played his trumpet, accompanied by his wife at the piano, "There Is Power In The Blood." Rev. Joe Ange introduced Mrs. Mabel Willy as the speaker. Her topic was, "All For Jesus In Activity." Her text was II Tim. 2:2 and Col. 1:28. Some of her thoughts were; The church is for the unifying of the believer; As preventive medicine, the world needs an inoculation by the church; The church must not isolate itself, but get involved.

For an invitation song, the congregation sang, "All for Jesus". The benediction was prayed by Rev. Ron Niebruegge.

**CONSTITUTION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF  
FREE WILL BAPTISTS OF N. C.**

1. The Annual General Conference will meet on Friday, following the first Sunday of November, beginning at 9 A.M. and concluding Friday evening with an evening service, provided this one day conference proves to be effective.
2. Every Elder, Minister and Preacher, in good standing, and Delegate, shall duly attend with convenience.
3. All the Delegates to the General Conference shall be chosen by the Church, that is to say, the Pastor shall first nominate, but if the Church shall fail to get a Delegate by the nominations of the Pastor, then twice the number shall be nominated and the lot cast, and the person on whom the lot falls shall be considered subservient.
4. The Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk-Treasurer and Assistant Clerk-Treasurer shall be elected annually and serve no more than two years successively in any one office or combination of these offices.
5. No member shall rise and speak in the Conference without first addressing the Moderator.
6. But one member shall speak at a time, and by order.
7. No member shall be at liberty to speak more than twice on any subject without leave of the Conference.
8. All matters shall be decided by a majority.
9. When the Conference is tied, the Moderator shall give the deciding vote.
10. If any member, in the judgment of the Conference, shall show anger in his discussion on any subject, he shall forfeit his seat in that Conference.
11. No member of the General Conference shall be at liberty to withdraw without leave of the Moderator.
12. The Conference shall always adjourn by vote.
13. There shall annually be a Committee of Finance chosen, to settle with the Treasurer and report to Conference.
14. The general Treasurer shall be entitled to a seat in the annual Conference.
15. It shall be the duty of the Conference, by their Clerk, to call the names of the Elders, Ministers and Preachers enrolled in the minutes of the last Conference, and the Conference shall examine and inquire into the state of the Ministry, in turn, as they are called for the past year.
16. No Elder, Minister, Preacher or Delegate shall, during the sitting of the General Conference, be at liberty to fill any place, as to preaching or hearing at the stage, only as liberty shall be granted by the Conference.
17. Every Elder, Minister, or Pracher, who shall be dealt with and excommunicated by order of the General Conference, shall be considered no member of the Baptist Church, but may, by repentance, be restored to membership by any one of the sister Churches, and by a recommendation from that Church to the General Conference may be restored to his ministerial office.
18. The names of the Delegates to the General Conference shall be enrolled in the Church's letters.
19. Conference shall always open and adjourn by prayer and praise to God.
20. The minutes of the Conference shall be signed by the Moderator and Clerk.
