

#### FRIDAY MORNING SESSION

The Friday morning session began with Bro. Doug Randlett leading the congregation in singing, "Standing On The Promises." Rev. Frank Davenport led the session in prayer. Rev. Bill Gardner sang a solo, "I'm Going Higher Some Day." Devotional remarks were made by Rev. Ron Niebruegge, pastor of Unity Free Will Baptist Church in Smithfield. His scriptural text was taken from Eph. 4:30.

Rev. Robert Durham, host pastor, welcomed the conference to the Grace Free Will Baptist Church.

Rev. Dean Dobbs, pastor of Shady Grove Free Will Baptist Church of Durham and moderator of this session, called the meeting to order. The moderator in his address to this session pointed out I Cor. 14:40 as a guideline for the conference meeting, "Let all things be done decently and in order."

The roll call of churches showed the following represented: Antioch-Pikeville, Calvary-Durham, Colonial Heights-Clinton, Faith-Goldsboro, Fellowship-Durham, Fellowship-Selma, First-Raleigh, First-Winston-Salem, Grace-Greenville, Grace-Rocky Mt., Grifton-Grifton, Hilltop-Fuquay, Hope-Scotland Neck, Joy-Tarboro, Liberty-Durham, Oak Grove-Durham, Parker's Chapel-Greenville, Peace-Wilson, Prospect-Dunn, Shady Grove-Durham, St. John-Goldsboro, Tippett's Chapel-Clayton, Trinity-LaGrange, Unity-Smithfield, Victory-Goldsboro, West Calvary-Smithfield.

Motion was made and carried to seat the delegates representing member churches of the General Conference.

The moderator recognized the visiting ministers. They were: Rev. Bill Gardner, White Castle, Indiana; Rev. Roger Reeds, Nashville, Tennessee; Rev. Jack Paramore, Nashville, Tennessee; Rev. L. C. Johnson, Nashville, Tennessee; Rev. Billy Morris, Norfolk, Virginia.

The moderator appointed the following committees: Digest Committee – Jack Avery, Lorenzo Stox, Fred Parker Resolutions Committee – Bill Robinson, Terry Beck, Eugene Hales Finance Committee – Ron Christ, Donald Walker, L. D. Creech Nominating Committee – Ralph Osborne, Ronnie Dale, Lee Zegelien

Motion was made and carried to approve the program for the day, giving the moderator authority to make necessary changes.

Recognition was given to the National Offices that were represented.

Rev. Frank Davenport brought greetings from the National Home Mission Board.

Rev. Roger Reeds gave a report for the Sunday School Dept. In his report he discussed the following items: Electives are being planned for Bible Study in the churches; Enlargement campaign shows increase in our Sunday School attendances; A new warehouse building has been purchased for Sunday School Dept. Offices have been moved; First Quarter literature in 1972 can now be ordered from Bible Book Store in Durham.

Rev. Herman Hersey gave a report for the Retirement Insurance Board. Some of the information he gave was, 30% of the pastors in the Retirement Plan come from the General Conference; A Life Insurance Program is now offered; New ways are being provided in helping churches by either purchasing or financing bonds.

Motion was made and carried to omit the reading of the minutes of the last session of the General Conference since printed copies were available for everyone.

Rev. Eugene Hales gave a report for the Church Training Service Department. Some of the information he gave was, Rev. Malcolm Fry has just been added to the office staff to work with the curriculum; The C. T. S. board is looking forward to a great meeting at the National Association in Texas; Area youth rallies are being planned all across the State of North Carolina.

Rev. Jack Paramore gave a report for the Free Will Baptist Bible College. Some of the information he gave was, plans are now being finalized for an Activity Building; \$750,000. is needed now for the next phase of the building program; Enrollment is up 25% over one year ago.

Dr. L. C. Johnson President of Free Will Baptist Bible College, gave greetings to the Conference.

Motion was made and carried to accept the reports from the National Offices as information.

Rev. Ronald Creech, our State Evangelist, gave a report on our Free Will Baptist Work in the State. He urged all our churches to start purchasing their Sunday School literature directly from the Bible Book Store beginning with the first quarter of 1972. He praised our State Moderator for his calling all the Boards of the State Association together to discuss long range plans for the State Association. We were reminded that the State Association meets June 12 - 14 at the Liberty Free Will Baptist Church in Durham, N. C. The Rest Home in Burnsville is debt free. Gov. Bob Scott has been approached about the State building a road to the mountain property. He asked everyone to continue always to pray for our State Missionaries and our Bible Book Store.

Rev. James Denton gave a report for our State Mission Board. He pointed out the three mission works that are being sponsored by the State Mission Board. The three missions are located in Lenoir, Clinton and Dunn. The need for more support from our churches was stressed. The Mission Board can only operate as the churches contribute their money.

The Conference was recessed for five minutes before the Worship hour.

The Morning Worship Hour began with Bro. Lee Zegelien leading the congregation singing, 'Since Jesus Came Into My Heart". Rev. Lonnie Graves led in prayer. The congregation then sang, "Power In The Blood". An offering was received, followed with Rev. Bill Gardner singing two songs, "Heaven Came Down" and "Christ Is All".

Rev. Herman Hersey introduced the guest speaker. Rev. Billy Morris, pastor of Hyde Park Free Will Baptist Church in Norfolk, Va. Rev. Morris' scripture text was taken from Romans 11:33. His message showed to us the promise to searchers to strike riches in the Word of God; for instance, Security is through the Word, Strength is found in the Word and Scenes from the future are found in the Word. An invitational song entitled "All For Jesus" was sung after the message. We were dismissed from the service by the Rev. Robert Durham.

#### FRIDAY AFTERNOON SERVICE

Rev. Eugene Hales led the afternoon session in singing "Joy Unspeakable". Rev. Harley Brown, pastor of Parker's Chapel Free Will Baptist Church, led with a devotion taken from Mark 1:21, 22 & 28 speaking on "The Authority of the Word of God".

Assistant Moderator, Rev. Ron Niebruegge, called the business meeting back in session.

Motion was made and carried to receive the Membership Committee's report.

Rev. Dennis Wiggs, pastor of First Free Will Baptist Church in Beaufort, N. C. spoke during a 6:15 p.m. luncheon on the subject, "Enabling the Shepherd". He stressed the importance of a pastor having a schedule to go by in utilizing his time.

#### FRIDAY EVENING SESSION

With Rev. Ronnie Peele, pastor of Victory Free Will Baptist Church of Goldsboro, presiding over the evening session, Mr. Lee Zegelien led the congregation singing, "I Know Whom I Have Believed". Rev. Gordon Hart led in prayer. Other congregational songs were, "Stand Up For Jesus" and "Banner of the Cross". An offering was received and special music was rendered by the host church. Rev. Bob Woodard introduced Missionary Bobby Aycock as the speaker. His topic was, "Evangelizing the Sinner". His text was Psalm 126: 1–6.

For an invitation song, the congregation sang, "All For Jesus". A prayer of of consecration was prayed by Rev. Robert Durham. Rev. L. D. Creech offered the prayer of benediction.

#### REPORT OF REVISION COMMITTEE

- 1, We recommend that six pastors be elected to serve as a committee to plan the division of the General Conference into two separate conferences; to get a team representation from the east and the west of the conference. It is suggested that three be elected from the east and the west of Interstate 95. This committee shall report to the 1972 session of the conference.
- 2. We recommend the following proposed Constitution of the General Conference of Free Will Baptists:
  - Article !. Name and Purpose. This organization shall be known as the General Conference of Original Free Will Baptists and by this name shall it be designated in all its work, government and fraternal relations. The general purpose of this Conference shall be the exaltation of Christ, the great Head of the Church; the edification of its members, through the effective teaching and mutual encouragement in the use of the manifold means of grace; the unification of the methods and programs of its affiliated churches and subordinate organizations; and the coordination of persistent efforts in church extension, christian education, benevolence and evangelism.
  - Article 2. <u>Composition.</u> This Conference shall be composed of the ordained and licensed ministers who are members of churches that are associated with the Conference and approved messengers from the churches.
  - Article 3. <u>Representation</u>. Voting privilege shall be accorded the pastor of each church in the Conference and five messengers from each church and one additional messenger for every 100 members or fraction thereof.
  - Article 4. <u>General Officers.</u> The general officers of this Conference shall be a moderator, an assistant moderator, a secretary-treasurer and an assistant secretary-treasurer, each of whom shall be elected for a term of two years beginning at the close of the annual session at which they are elected.

#### Article 5. Committees.

Section 1. The executive committee shall consist of the general officers of the Conference together with two members elected from the churches at large for a term of two years. It is understood that this committee has no authority other than that which is expressly stated in these constitution and by-laws.

Section 2. A membership committee of six shall be elected for three years, the tenure of two expiring each year.

Section 3. Special committees may be elected or appointed at the option of the conference.

Article 6. Ordination. The General Conference recognizes that the authority to ordain ministers has its source in the local church.

# Article 7. <u>Meetings</u>. The annual session of the conference shall meet on Friday following the first Sunday in November.

- Article 8. Adoption and Amendment.
  - A. This constitution shall be adopted at any regular session by a twothirds majority vote of the messengers present.
  - B. It may be amended at any regular session by a two-thirds majority vote of the messengers present.

3. We recommend the following proposed By-Laws of the General Conference of Free Will Baptists:

Section 1. Officers. No person shall serve more than three years successively in any one office or combination of officers.

- A. The moderator shall preside, according to accepted parliamentary precedure, over the sessions of the Conference.
- B. The duties of the assistant moderator shall be those of the moderator when the latter shall so direct or when he is absent.
- C. The secretary-treasurer shall record the proceedings of all sessions of the Conference and perserve an accurate record of said proceedings in a book provided for this purpose. He shall hold in trust all money that belongs to the Conference and pay out same by order of the Conference. He shall keep an accurate account of all funds received and paid out and make an annual report accordingly to the Conference.
- D. The duties of the assistant secretary-treasurer shall be those of the secretary-treasurer when the latter shall so direct or when he is absent.

#### Section 2. Committees.

- A. The executive committee shall plan the program for the annual session in consultation with the host pastor. They shall perform any other duties as directed by the Conference in session.
- B. The membership committee shall examine the credentials of ministers who apply for membership in the Conference and applications of churches that desire membership in the Conference and shall make recommendations according to their judgments.

Section 3. <u>Ordination</u>. The General Conference recognizes the authority of the local church to ordain men to the ministry of the gospel. It further recognizes the authority of the local church to ordain men to general christian ministries. The following is suggested procedure in the ordination of a minister.

A. The candidate should be licensed for at least one year.

- B. The church should call together at least three ministers to examine the candidate as to doctrine and general qualifications. This committee should make written recommendations to the church.
- C. The ordination service generally includes a sermon, presentation of the Bible, charge to the candidate, laying on of hands and prayer of dedication.

#### Section 4. Adoption and Amendment.

- A. This by-laws shall be adopted at any regular session by a twothirds majority vote of the messengers present.
- B. It may be amended at any regular session by a two-thirds majority vote of the messengers present.
