Lunch was prepared by a local restaurant at the expense of the Cuyahoga Lorrain quarterly meeting.

The afternoon devotions were led by the assistant moderator Rev. Hobart Ashby.

Henry Davis of the Ohio Valley yearly meeting gave a report of their meeting, the messengers to other bodies had no report.

Messengers appointed to other bodies for the coming year were Scioto: Rev. Charles Wright and Paul Thompson. Ky. State: Virgil Wooten. Great Lakes: Richard Presnell and Billy McCarty. Ohio Valley: Melvin Sanford.

Sister McCarty gave a talk concerning ladies auxillary work and encouraged more interest in it. Rev. Billy McCarty gave a talk on State and Mational papers published by the FreeWill Baptist and encouraged all to purchase books and bibles from our book store. He also gave a report on the National association.

The resolution committee recomended that we oppose the sale of liquor on Sunday. This was ammended and passed that the clerk notify the Governor and State Senate of our disapproval of this bill now pending and to notify the press also of our stand.

The appreciation committee extended thanks to the Cuyahoga Lorrain conference for sponsoring the lunch and to Rev. Carl Vallance for the message.

The obituary committee reported deaths of Rev. John VanHoose, Bro. Henry Young and broIke Moore and bro. Baker of the franklin county conference. Sister Rosie Moore, Sister Beatty and Bro. Young of the central Ohio conference. A moment of silent prayer in memory of these was observed while all stood.

The yearly meeting voted to oppose the transportation of parochial students on public owned busses.

The executive board recomended that districts be established and all churches located therin shall join themselves to that quarterly meeting. This was tabled for consideration and the following men were appointed as a committee to make a study of this, Robert Prichard, John Jeffreys, Bill Pitts, Roy Hutchinson, Norman Livingston, Clyde Perry, Quenton England, Billy McCarty, this also was sent to the State association as a recommendation from the yearly meeting.

A recommendation to request quarterly meetings to consolidate smaller churches that are in the same area and to promote full time pastors for them was rejected.

The meeting voted to have the conference clerks send a list of their ministers to the yearly meeting clerk and that good standing cards would be issued in the yearly meeting instead of the ministerial meeting, also a list is to be sent to the ministerial clerk.

Rev. Hobart Ashby was elected as three year man on the executive board to replace Rev. Thomas Moore whose term expired.

The State Association letter was read and approved. Rev. C.A. Newman was elected as moderator for coming year and the meeting was adjourned.
