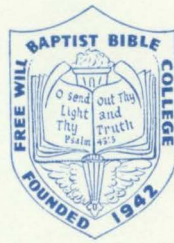

REPORTS

Business Committee:

1. We the Business Committee recommend that all candidates for State Evangelist turn in an application to Home Mission Board and be elected from the floor.

1. We resolve that action be taken on Article 2 of resolution of last year before selection of State Evangelist. Carried.

2. We recommend that the State Evangelist salary be increased to \$75 per week. Rejected M.S.C. Salary remains at \$200.00 per month, plus \$1300 expense account.

3. Recommend that we pay our representative of the General Board \$150 on his trip to California to attend the National Association. Hereafter, to pay 7 cents per mile (map miles) both ways on his trip to the National Association.

4. We recommend that the Association Moderator be elected from the floor, the present Moderator be moderator of the coming year.

The State Association shall elect a Credential Committee before the close of each session which will meet with the State Association Clerk two weeks before the State Association to prepare their report for presentation at the Friday morning session.

The association neglected to appoint this Committee, and the Executive Committee will act this year as committee on credentials.

We recommend that the State Association receive the delegates and ministers from the

Scioto Yearly Conference and Miami Valley Conference be seated. We reject the Ohio River Yearly Conference as they have failed to comply with the rules of the Association and have the Executive Committee set with them and explain the rules of said Association, and find out what they wish to do.



CONSTITUTION

- Article 1 - This association shall be called the Ohio State Association of Free Will Baptists and shall be composed of all regularly organized and disciplined Free Will Baptist yearly meetings as may embody themselves under this constitution.
- Article 2 - The purpose of this association is to promote the cause of Christ among our people and bring a better spirit of union among our several quarterly meetings.
- Article 3 - The officers of this association shall be a clerk, an assistant clerk and a treasurer, who shall serve at the pleasure of this association, a moderator, who shall be elected one year in advance of the year he shall serve and the assistant moderator elected from the floor.
- Article 4 - The members of this association shall consist of ten (10) delegates from each yearly meeting, together with all ordained authority and licentiates belonging to same.
- Article 5 - Any well organized and well regulated yearly meeting in the state shall, by application and conforming to the usages of the Free Will Baptist denomination, shall be received into this association by a majority vote of the association.

cont' (constitution)

Article 6 - The session of this association shall be held on Friday before the fourth Saturday in June, 9:30 A.M., the place being in any yearly meeting as requested and placed by vote of the association.

Article 7 - This association shall have power to adopt any regulations and by-laws that are consistent with this constitution or usages of the Free Will Baptist denomination.

Article 8 - This constitution may be altered or amended by vote of this association at any session by a two-thirds majority vote.

BY-LAWS

- Section 1 - The clerk shall call the association to order and in his absence the oldest minister present shall call the association to order.
- Section 2 - It shall be the duty of each body belonging to the association to send a letter giving statistics of the body.
- Section 3 - Each meeting shall be opened by reading of scripture and prayer.
- Section 4 - The association shall sit with open doors except when it goes into a committee as a whole.
- Section 5 - No person shall nominate more than one person if that person be elected.
- Section 6 - The moderator shall not allow any conversation except it be in a Christian spirit or when he thinks it will cause discord.
- Section 7 - Anyone desiring to speak must arise to his feet and address the moderator.
- Section 8 - Voting must be done by the show of the right hand.
- Section 9 - No member shall be allowed to speak more than twice on any subject and not more than five minutes at a time.

cont' (by-laws)

- Section 10 - It shall be the duty of the moderator to seat the delegates in a convenient place.
- Section 11 - All ordained ministers, deacons and licentiates are standing members.
- Section 12 - The form of financing the state association shall be one collection from each church year, and one collection to be taken at association. Yearly meeting dues \$10.00 per year.
- Section 13 - That all standing boards must be in session called by the chairman to make money appropriations.
- Section 14 - That this association pay the Clerk \$25 each year.
- Section 15 - That this association be governed by the National Treatise.
- Section 16 - That all members of the State Association, relative to the ministers that all ministers be male members only. That no minister can be a member of this Association who has two living wives, or whose wife has two living husbands.
- Section 17 - The Executive Board of the association be authorized to receive committee reports and transact any necessary business that may demand attention of the association any

time during the year when the association is not in session.

Section 18 - These by-laws may be altered or amended by a two-thirds vote of members present

The Executive Board is made up of: Moderator Ass't Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer and 1 member-at-large, who is elected annually by the association.
