MSC to receive report. MSC that Article 1 of State Constitution be changed as above recommendation. MSC to amend this: that the Ex. Combe empowered to work out the voting power.

OHIO STATE ASSOCIATION REPORT

The Ohio State Association convened June 26 and 27 with the First Springfield Church, 401 N. Belmont, Springfield, Ohio. Approximately 175 registered, however, it was estimated 250 attended the Friday evening service.

Friday morning devotions were conducted by Rev. Henry Hawkins. The Assistant Clerk, Rev. James A. Hayes, called the meeting into the official business session and introduced the Moderator, Rev. Delmar Sparks. Rev. Elmer Sizemore asked to be excused from serving as the Assistant Moderator. His request was granted and Rev. Henry Hawkins was elected to serve in this capacity.

The Yearly Meetings reported by letter, except the Great Lakes Conference. A Change in Article 1 of the Constitution was made to include the words "or Associations" after Yearly Meetings. This will now read "This association shall be called the Ohio State Association of Free Will Baptists and shall be composed of all regularly organized and disciplined Free Will Baptist yearly meetings or associations as may embody themselves under this constitution. The Executive Committee was authorized to decide the change to be made in Article 4 regarding the number of delegates from each Yearly Conference or Association. Article 5 to be changed accordingly.

The Toledo Conference was received and given the hand of fellowship. Special singing during worship services was furnished by the Allen Williams, Jr., Family. On Friday evening Bro. Steve Ashby also sang. The Keynote message by Rev. Hobert Ashby was in keeping with the theme "Press Toward The Mark". This was a very inspiring message. He mentioned the minister should not become so involved in other things that he would neglect the one thing he was called to do—preach the Word—but that he should let lay members do the things they are called or qualified to do, while he uses his time for preparation and preaching the Word.

Friday afternoon devotions were conducted by Rev. Robert Pritchard and Friday evening by Rev. Franklyn Harness. Our missionary to the Ivory Coast of Africa, Rev. Archie Mayhew delivered a very good message and told some of his experiences in the work in the Ivory Coast. Saturday morning devotions were led by Rev. Andrew Workman and the message by Rev. Jerry Hager. He too used the theme "Press Toward The Mark". Saturday afternoon devotions were led by Rev. Clarence Newman. It was a joy to be in these services. A wonderful spirit of love prevailed from the beginning to the end, both in the devotions and the business sessions.

You will note on page two of this issue the changes on the Executive Committee and State Mission Board. The State Missions reports on Youngstown, Creston and Cincinnati were given by the men working in these areas, Rev. Billie McCarty, Rev. Millard Green, Rev. Eddie Dollar. The State Mission Board plan to

support the Youngstown Church \$200 monthly this next year, Creston \$100 monthly and Cincinnati \$100.00 monthly. They ask that we support the work prayerfully and financially. Double our giving if possible. Continue to send your money for state missions to Rev. Robert Mead. Any contribution earmarked for a special account will be used for it.

Rev. Danny Widdig is to serve five years on the Sunday School Board. Rev. Richard Pressnell to serve four years on State Mission Board. Rev. James A. Hayes is the General Board Member to National. State CTS Director is Alex Pressnell. Next year's Moderator will be Rev. Henry Hawkins, with Rev. Hobert Ashby as Assistant Moderator. Rev. James Cox, Jerry Hager and Elmer Sizemore were appointed to the Resolution Committee to work during this year and report at next session.

The National offices were represented by Rev. Homer Willis, Rev. & Mrs. Bert Tippett, Rev. Henson and son, N. R. Smith and Missionary Rev. Archie Mayhew. Some offices were represented by letter. We certainly were happy to have them with us.

Our Treasurer reported only a small amount (less than \$350.00) was received during the year marked for the Bible Institute. He also reported only 22 churches had sent their offering for the State Association, and three churches paid the 1.00 fee for a delegate. You may still send your offerings to Rev. Plan now to attend the next session, which will convene June 25, 26, 1971 at Welch Avenue Church, Columbus, Ohio.

I also attended most of the Woman's Auxiliary State Convention and enjoyed it very much. Their featured speakers were Molly Barker, Missionary Nurse to Uruguay, and Eunice Edwards, former National Executive Secretary of the W.N.A.C. Their messages were a blessing.

The Youth participated in the afternoon service and our state will again be represented by the Youth at the National Association this year.

The new project is the Jim and Shirley Combs account, with a goal of \$2000.00. Perhaps the Woman's Auxiliary officers will give a more complete report later on the convention.

I would like to say "thank you" to those who assisted with the registration, to the Little Miami River Quarterly Meeting Churches who served the meals each day, and to the First Springfield Church for their kind hospitality to this association, and to all those who prayed that it might be a good convention. Bro. Mayhew reminded us of the importance of prayer in his message about the missionaries and the danger they sometimes face.
