Moderator seated delegates.

Billie McCarty. <u>Obituary</u> — Morris Justice, Charles Wright, Hershel Salyers. <u>Appreciation</u> — Rev. Richard Pressnell, Rev. Melvin Sanford, Rev. Andrew Workman. <u>Nominating Committee</u> — Rev. Billie McCarty, three year term.

Assistant Moderator, Rev. Robert Frichard elected. Our records indicate Assistand Moderator was already elected. Rev. Hobert Ashby to be Assistant Moderator this year. MSC to let today's election stand in event Bro. Ashby does not attend. Bro Ashby did arrive and fill office.

Report Of The Ohio State Association

The 33rd annual session of the Ohio State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Welch Avenue Church in Columbus, Ohio, on June 25, 26, 1971. Theme of this meeting was "That We May Know Him", Phil. 3:10.

Rev. Paul Thompson, pastor of the church, led the Friday morning devotions and gave the welcome address. Allen Williams, Jr. served as song leader and his wife, Evelyn, as pianist. Rev. Robert Trimble sang "When He Reached Down His Hand For Me". Rev. Richard Pressnell gave response to the welcome.

During the morning worship the Williams family sang. Rev. Norman Livingston delivered the keynote message using the theme, "That We May Know Him", Phil. 3:10. This was a wonderful and stirring message.

The afternoon devotions were led by Rev. James Sizemore. Prayer by Rev. Andrew Workman. The evening service was led by Rev. Don Pegram, member of the State Mission Board. Prayer offered by Rev. Homer Willis of the National Home Mission Department. An offering of \$88.00 was received for missions. Special singing by Barbara Chaffin and the Allen Williams family. A stirring testimony by Rev. Franklyn Harness. Message by Rev. Bill Jones, former missionary to Africa.

The Saturday morning devotions were led by Rev. Clarence A. Newman. Bro. James Conkey led the singing while his wife, Janet, served as pianist. Prayer by Rev. William Chadwick. Rev. Newman referred to our theme and spoke briefly on the need of power in our Christian life.

In the morning worship service a special prayer was offered by Rev. Homer Willis. Special singing by Bro. James Conkey and the Williams family. Testimony by Rev. John Jeffrey. The message by Rev. Clyde Perry using the theme "The Account of Revival" from Matt. 17:1-9, text from verse 4, "Lord, it is good for us to be here". This was an outstanding message also. He brought out that we need REVIVAL. A reviving or rekindling time; an Experience that Peter had; Visitation from God; Inventory in our Christian life; Vision; All for Jesus; Labor, Love and Loyalty.

After the message, a time of fellowship was enjoyed by all. Rev. Paul Thompson gave a wonderful testimony. Benediction was offered by Rev. Quentin England.

The afternoon devotions were led by Rev. Bill Pitts, with prayer by Bro. Field Justice. Scripture reading from Nehemiah 4:1-6, 19-21.

Our Moderator for this meeting was Rev. Henry Hawkins, assisted by Rev. Hobert Ashby. In the absence of our Clerk and Assistant Clerk, Sis. Charity Sparks served as Clerk Pro Tem. Our moderator referred to the theme in his message, bringing out points (1) That We need to Know His Will (2) To Do His Will (3) To Know Him in Power (4) To Know Him in Fellowship (5) To Know Him In Fellowship among the brethren (6) To Share His Suffering (7) To Know Him As Personal Saviour.

All letters from conferences reporting were received except the Great Lakes. This was placed in the hands of the Executive Committee because it did not comply with our By-Law Sec. 2, since they did not report statistics or ministers.

Our Clerk, Rev. Homer Nelson, resigned after 14 years of service because of his health. This resignation was accepted with a standing vote of thanks in appreciation of work well done. Rev. Richard Pressnell was elected as our new clerk. Member-at-Large elected was Rev. Clarence A. Newman.

The National offices reported as follows: Sunday School Dept. by N. R. Smith; Executive Secretary, Rufus Coffey; Bible College — by Dr. Robert Picrilli; Foreign Missions — Rev. Bill Jones; National Church Training Service — Rev. Fred Green. A testimony was given by Peter Wilson, an Ohio Student at the Bible College. The National Home Missions Dept. was represented by Rev. Homer Willis. (We were happy to have his wife with us also). He informed us there will be an Evangelism Conference November 10th in Nashville.

We agreed to send our clerk to the National Promotional Meeting in Nashville, January 3-6, 1972. Delegates volunteering for the National Association were: Franklin Beverly, Morris Justice, Robert Webb, Luther Newsome, Henry Davis, alternate — Elmer Sebastian.

The churches are encouraged to support the National Executive Department either thru the Cooperative Plan or direct giving. Rev. Franklyn Harness and Rev. Richard Pressnell resigned from the State Mission Board. See page 2 of this issue for the names of those now on this board. A report of the National Association was given by Rev. Hobert Ashby. No reports by the Sunday School Board or CTS Director. Sis. Pauline Patrick reported for the Woman's Auxiliary State Convention.

Resolutions adopted were: (1) That each quarterly meeting or yearly meeting reporting send a fee of \$10 per church they represent instead of the previous \$10 fee. (2) That we join with Franklin Conference in protesting the use of Text Books or magazines in schools using Profanity in them. A committee to go personally to the State Superintendent of Schools. (3) To encourage each church to send their pastor to the National. (4) To suggest each minister inform the clerk of any change of address.

It was agreed to have a digestive report of the letters mimeographed prior to the next State meeting for distribution. Also agreed to have Constitution and By-Laws reprinted after corrections. When the Treasurer's report was given it was encouraging to note we had 13 church delegates this year, but sad to know that less than 50% of our churches contributed. However, you may still do this.
