Something in which to invest prayer and gifts 3. Someone in whom to pray and share, Third, encourage participation in the affairs of the church, conference, and denominational enterprises. Whereas, involvement creates a sense of belonging and meaningful fulfillment, we recommend a committee to provide and promote such be formed consisting of our Moderator, Home Mission Chairman, Youth Board Chairman, and Promotional Secretary to implement such a program during this coming year.
