- 4 Resolved that Samuel S. Branch be Treasurer for the ensuing year
- 5 Resolved that Benjamin Shivers be Clerk for the ensuing year
- 6 Heard the letters from the Quarterly Meetings; Miss Quarterly Meeting Reports Union, but no particular reformation and for various reasons have been obliged to drop Kyger Church, and because of removals and other causes it was thought by the L. M. but for the remaining members of the first Church in Alexander to unite with the second Church in Alexander so but one Church remains in Alexander and that there has been a great lack Gospel laborers within the L. M. for the year past although Elder Thorn had traveled a part of the time Reports but one ordained preacher one licentiate and one ruling elder as a quarterly meeting the cause of Temperance is advocated and deeply deplore the awful sin of American Slavery
