Alexander, August 7, 1846.

The Ohio River Yearly Meeting convened at
Alexander, Athens Co. Ohio, Aug. 7, 1846.

1. Opened meeting with singing and prayer.
2. Chose Eld. G. A. Stebbins, moderator, and
brother C. E. Price, assistant clerk.
3. Read the record of the last Yearly Meeting,
and accepted it.

4. Heard the reports of the quarterly meetings.
Meigs Q. M. reported 9 churches, 6 preachers, 19 added,
10 dismissed, 16 excluded, 2 died, present No. of members
397. The Q. M. is low in religion. The Q. M. sends
Elders S. S. Branch, G. A. Stebbins, Wm. Cooper, and
brother Edward Dudley, as delegates. The Q. M. also
requests the next Y. M. to be held within its bounds.

The Athens Q. M. reported 5 churches, 1 Eld.
and 4 Licentiated. The present No. is 115.

The Scioto Q. M. was not reported, either
by delegates or letter.

5. Voted, That the next Y. M. be held with the
Meigs Q. M., commencing on Friday before the 2d Sat. in Aug.

6. Voted, That S. Barrett and C. E. Price be a
committee to form a resolution, expressive of the
views of the Yearly Meeting on Slavery.

7. Voted, That we adjourn till after the P. M. services.

8. Heard the report of the committee.

9. Voted, That the report be laid over till
the next session of this Yearly Meeting.

10. Voted, That we adjourn.
