The Ohio River Y. M. convention at  
Rutland, Ohio, Aug. 10, 1849.

Organized by choosing Elder J.  
Kittle, moderator, and S. Barrett, assistant.  
Read the record of the last Y. M.  
Heard the reports from the 2. M's  
which were as follows:-

Miss 2. M. "During the past  
year, some two or three churches have  
been favored with revivals, and some  
accessions made to them. At present  
there are no special revivals, but union  
and harmony exist. There are 9 churches,  
3 ordained ministers, 2 licentiates, 412  
members, being a net increase of 25  
members."

Visits 2. M. Reported as follows:  
"Elder J. Rice had moved to Ill., and  
Elder J. C. Harding, to Iowa the past  
year, and brother Stephen Kittle, a licentiate,  
had died. Present number of preachers,  
are 3 Elders and 2 Licentiates."

Atkins 2. M. Reported that  
it had been a low time with them. But  
God had revived His work in Leodin church.  
Backsliders were reclaimed, and some twelve  
converted and added to the church.  
Also, a reformation in Alexander  
church. Ten had been converted, and  
others were seeking the Lord.  
Preachers, one Elder, and two Licentiates.



Voted, That brethren be permitted to join in the discussions of Conference.

Voted, That the 13th article be erased from the Constitution of this Yearly Meeting.

Voted, That the 11th vote, passed at Chester, September 27, 1844, be erased.

Voted, That the 16th article be altered that the Minister's Conference be on Saturday. Conference adjourned after meeting of worship, after which resolutions were passed upon the subjects of War, Slavery, Intemperance, Sabbath Schools, &c.

Voted, That the next Y. M. be held with Scioto Quarterly Meeting.
