association if and when he joins another association or when he is adjudged by ministers conference to be disqualified to preach the gospel in compliance to our faith.

4. Council shall or ordain any person qualifing by rules of THE PILGRIM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST.

5.Council shall not issue credentials to brothern who have two living companions with out a Bible rights.

6. This council must not use partiality in the issuance of credentials.

7. These rules must be read to each minister asking for entrance into this association.

8. The ordination council shall have ministers conference suthority in the finterim.

## ARTICLES OF FAITH

L.THE BIBLE. The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments were given by infallible rule of faith and practice.

2.GOD: There is one living and true God, revealed in nature as the Creater, Preserver, and Righteous Governor of the universe; and in the Scriptures as Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, yet as one God, infinitely wise and good, whom the creatures are supremely to love, adore, and obey.

## ARTICLES OF FAITH

- 4. THE HOLY SPIRIT. The Scriptures assign to the Holy Spirit all the attributes of God.
- 5. THE GOVERNMENT OF GOD. God exercises a wise and benevolent providence over all beings and all things by maintaining the constitution and laws of nature. He also performs special acts, not otherwise provided for, as the highest welfare of men requires.
- 6. THE SINFULNESS OF MAN. Man was created innocent, but by disobedience fell into a state of sin and condemnation. His posterity therefore, inherit a fallen nature of such tendencies that all who come to years of accountability, sin and becomes guilty before God.
- 7. THE WORK OF CHRIST. The Son of God by His incarnation, life, sufferings, death, and resurrection effected for all a redemption from sin that is full and free, and is the ground of salvation by faith.
- 8. THE TERMS OF SALVATION. The conditions of salvation are: 1. Repentance or sincere sorrow for sin and hearty renunciation of it. 2. Faith or the unreserved committal of one's self to Christ as Saviour and Lord with purpose to love and obey Him in all things. In the exercise of saving faith, the soul is renewed by the Holy Spirit, freed from the dominion of sin, and becomes a child of God. 3. Contunuance in faith and obedience until death.
- 9. ELECTION. God determined from the beginning to save all who would comply with the conditions of salvation. Hence by faith in Christ men become His elect.

principle sacred and Christian obligations

and enterprises supreme.

Counting it our chief business in life to extend the influence of Christ in society, constantly praying and toiling that the Kingdom of God will come, and His will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The ministers conference shall dect ordaining council.

2.Ordaining council shall have conference authority in the interim.

3. Ministers failing to send a report to the annual association shall subject name be put on nominal roll of ministers.

## RULES GOVERNING ORDINATION COUNCIL

L. No minister may be granted license or certificate of ordination unless he presents a letter of recommendation from the church of which he is a member.

2. No licensed minister may be ordained under three(3) monthes from date of

licerse.

3.All ministers being admitted to this association must promise to give up the crodentials they hold from this

10. FREEDOM OF THE WILL. The human will is free and self-controlled, having power to yield to the influence of the truth and the Spirit, or to resist them and perish.

11. SALVATION FREE. God desires the salvation of all, the Gospel invites all, the Holy Spirit strives with all, and whosever will may come and take

of the water of life freely.

12.PERSEVERANCE. All believers in Christ, who through grace perserve in holiness to the end of life, have promise of eternal salvation.

- 13.GOSPEL ORDINANCES. Baptism, or the immersion of believers in water, and the Lord's Supper are ordinances to be perpetuated under the Gospel. Feet Washing, an ordinance teaching humility of universal obligation, and to be ministered to all true believers.
- 14. TITHING. God commanded tithes and offerings in the Old Testament: Jesus Christ endorses it in the Gospel (Matt.23:23), and the apostle Paul said, "Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him." (1 Cor.16:2)
- 15. THE CHRISTIAN SABBATH. The divine law requires that one day in seven be set apart from secular employments and amusements, for rest, worship, holy works, and activities, and for personal communion with God.
- 16.RESURRECTION. Judgment and Final Retribution. The Scriptures teach the resurrection of all men at the last day. They that have done good (continued on page/7)

# PILGRIM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST CONSTITUTION

1. This association shall be composed of delegates elected by churches of this body to represent the churches annually.

2. The association when assembled, shall first elect a moderator and clerk.

3. Rules of the decorum must be read immediately after the association is

immediately after the association is assembled.

4. The association will encourage a sound ministry, such as presents Christ all sufficient Saviour, that the plan of salvation presented by Christ; is strictly and definitely grace, and as presented by the gospel, will save all human beings who accept it.

5. Any minister, in good standing with their church or association may be invited to a seat in our council, take part in our deliberations and their name be enrolled in our minutes.

6. It is the duty of the association to appoint or elect, committees to take

care of special business, each committee report must be in writing and turned in to the clerk for reading before the assembly.

9. The association may withdraw from any church who walks disorderly or violates any rule made and passed on by this body.

10.It is to be understood that this body assumes no higher authority than an advisory council.

1. Any minister found casting his influence against any church or in any way marring the character unjustly of another minister or working to secure the church of another minister will be doalt with by the ministers conference.
